Aim of the course	Teaching the students about basic problems of kinetic object modelling. The learned skills will be useful for making models which include movable elements, as inevitable parts of student projects and needed to be modelled in order to verify an idea, as well as for presentation purposes.
Prerequisites	Knowledge about simple machines resulting from secondary education. Basic manual skills.
Learning outcomes:	
- knowledge	Student gains knowledge about methods of working with motion effects and movement modification using modelling methods, gets to know the materials, suitable for processing, and for making movable models, as well as elements which carry and change the movement in models, which are not subject to real pressure.
- skills	Using the skills needed for making movable elements and models using easily accessible materials. Ability to substitute industrial processing methods with modelling methods, achieving the same final effect, however of lower

	durability and resistance to pressure.
- personal and social competence	
Course content	Students make a modelf which contains a set of basic elements of transferring propulsion and gearshift, which can perform a given, simple task. The model's propulsion is triggered by the energy of human hand muscles. The spatial structure of the movable model should be well thought out and executed with special consideration for the qualities of materials used.
