Aim of the course	Learning the advanced problems in the area of designing and shaping interiors. Deeper study of form and function. Developing the methodology of design with special emphasis on the process of adjusting author's own concepts to the functional, constructional, technical and material aspects. Using available presentation techniques in design work.
Prerequisites	Knowledge and skills gained at the 1st year bachelor's degree level.
Learning outcomes:	
- knowledge	Student gains advanced knowledge regarding theoretical questions of design. Consciously takes up and solves complex design tasks. Has advanced knowledge about the norms of technical drawings as well as regulations regarding private and public spaces.
- skills	Student has the advanced ability to create formal structures and to equip different types of interiors. Can perform a correct analysis of design conditions, collecting initial data to make an individual, complete resolution of
