Aim of the course	The main aim of the course is solving the creative problems, that require interpreting of concepts and referring to the student's own preferences and interests. Development of workshop skills and knowledge on glass moulding techniques.
Prerequisites	Mastering of basic workshop skills.
Learning outcomes:	
– knowledge	The student has a basic knowledge on the glass moulding techniques. They are aware of the artistic glass discipline integrity and use the concepts of this discipline. They understand the dependency between a conception and realization technique.
– skills	The student makes independent decisions on creating and realizing of artistic projects. They are able to interpret and express themselves through the works made of glass. They creatively use their workshop and manual skills. The student consciously uses their knowledge on glass in the process of creating their own artistic conceptions.
personal and social competence	The student can analyze and critically assess given artistic issues. They are able to present and discuss a selected problem, based on previously collected information.
Course content	Solving the creational problems, that help the student determine their own creative preferences. Drawing attention to the role of the recipient in the perception of artistic objects. Searching for individual forms of expression. Provoking of ideological and technological experiments. The use and further improvement of the student's workshop skills.
