– knowledge	Students broaden their knowledge of general Spanish using authentic materials on Fine Arts. Students know basic expressions and terminology related to all areas of art.
– skills	Students can produce oral and written statements about their own artistic creativity. They understand written content and specific terminology used in educational videos devoted to Fine Arts.
