

Aim of the course	Developing and establishing an individual, creative interpretation of nature. "Grinding" by the student his own creative attitude and forming of artistic awareness. Building of an individual set of sculptural means of expression, own scultural language, for the purpose of materialization of own ideas and creative intentions.
Prerequisites	Students of sculpture in our ASP
	Graduation of the third year of the sculpture. Portfolio, photos, videos own achievements in the field of sculpture.
	<u>Others</u>
	Ability of conscious nature interpretation. Ability of diverse sculptural interpretation, from the simple to the complex. Documentation of own achievements with noticeable features of own language of sculptural expression - portfolio, photos, videos.
	The decision on engagement to workshop at the discretion of the atelier.
Learning outcomes:	
- knowledge	The student is aware of the individual language of artistic expression. Is able to freely move in problems of contemporary sculptural enunciations.
– skills	Gained workshop experiences allow him unconstrained recording of own concepts as a response to the issues raised by the tutor. Student is able to customize his "statements" in the area of sculpture.
– personal and social competence	Student understands the need to confront his achievements in the field of sculpture with other artists during the open art exhibitions. Student is able to work with other artists in collective projects concerning widely understood field of contemporary sculpture.
Course content	SEMESTER - nude act in the own compositional arrangement or composition on an act, size dependent on the composition, material: modeling clay, - the head - study: size ca 1:1.5, material: modeling clay, - composition "My Music" or own proposal (one of the given topics), - Own theme "in the circle of own interests", any form of execution SEMESTER 8
	 nude act of own idea, head – study or reduction of a third dimension, size greater than 1:1, material: modeling clay, composition on "Woman and Man", any material, own topic – a concept on the subject of diploma.
