Aim of the course	
Prerequisites	ability to apply acquired knowledge to continue the educational process; openness to diversity of artistic phenomena; willingness to cognitive and artistic creativity.
Learning outcomes:	
– <i>knowledge</i>	- The student acquires the knowledge to understand the expanded image plane - Is aware of the differences between the interpretation of such categories as: sign, symbol, letter - Raise awareness of the modern conventions of drawing
– <i>skills</i>	- Is able to solve the system of the image plane by the adopted criteria - Knows how to make their own decisions regarding the selection of operating techniques relevant to the style of work
– <i>personal and social competence</i>	- Self-analysis work done in the context of contemporary culture - Publicly verbalize their ideas during maintenance work.
Course content	The issue of building the image plane. Types of compositional harmony and dissonance. Linear Imaging - redefining the concepts of drawing. Semantic dimension drawing - the Art of Translation. Sign - symbol - letter - the scope of interpretative concepts. Preparing your own work collection. Self-analysis work.
Course form and number of course hours	Classes are held in an artist's studio, are exercises, individual adjustments, individual or team projects. Number of hours per week: 8 hours.
Assessment methods and criteria	The final grade is the sum of the following sub-ratings: 1. Inspections Internal Working -70% 2. Final review - 30%
