	student learns to take independent decisions in the area of their own creation, and
	individually chooses projects for realization. The student realizes glass objects
	(sculpture, installation, etc.), and independently makes decisions on the selection of
	the most adequate techniques for the implementation of their own conceptions. The
	student can synthetically describe the creative process. Based on their own experience,
	the student prepares propositions of the topics for their diploma project.
Prerequisites	The student is the graduate of the bachelor's degree studies of the department of
	artistic glass.
	The student is the graduate of the bachelor's degree studies of a different department,
	with programme differences complemented. (theoretical and practical knowledge of
	glass-making techniques, the history of art in the area of glass, etc.)

	artistic work. They are able to list and define their inspirations. They can define artistic
	phenomena and draw conclusions at every stage of the creative process.
