Academic aims	The course is a component of instruction in the direction: Media Art. The aim of the course is deepening the students' knowledge of postproduction and film animation.
Module prerequisites	Fundamental knowledge of film editing and film image postproduction. Capability of utilizing software supporting film image realization.
Learning outcomes with respect to:	
- knowledge	The student deepens knowledge from the area of Media Art in the range of creating and processing digital film image, integrating its computer-generated elements with video material. Besides he/she obtains knowledge of modern software and systems supporting film image postproduction.
– skills	The student obtains skills from the area Media Art in the range of utilizing advanced functions and scripting in film image postproduction software environment.
personal and social competence	The student becomes partner for directors, art managers, creative managers, etc. in planning digital image postproduction.
Module content	Workshop involving film production realization with focus on advanced techniques of image postproduction, composition of film image with elements generated in 3D graphics software and stereoscopic techniques.
