Entity running the course	Faculty of Painting and Sculpture / Department of Painting
Entity for which the course has been prepared	Department of Ceramics
Course type	Compulsory course, core course.
Year of studies/semester; Type of studies	Year I, sem. 1 and 2; full time bachelor's degree studies
ECTS credits	Semester I – 4, semester II – 3.
Academic tutor	To be chosen by a separate list.
Aim of the course	The aim of the course is to enable the student to acquire basic workshop skills, as well as extending the student's visual, reflective and manual capabilities, so as to allow a free painting expression.
Prerequisites	Entrance exam passed. Correct eyesight, manual predispositions, sense of a form and colour.
Learning outcomes:	
– <i>knowledge</i>	The student acquires a basic knowledge in the area of easel painting.
– <i>skills</i>	The student acquires basic skills to perform painting assignments in the studio.
– <i>personal and social competence</i>	The student makes attempts to formulate opinions and judgments. They learn to work in a team.
Course content	Working with nature and still life is the starting point and one of the basic components of the exercises the student needs to perform in their learning process. The exercises are based on sophisticated painting contrasts set together according to diversified ranges of colour determining the direction of the image organization and harmonization. A compulsory plein air practice is a complement to the program.
Course form and number of course hours	Classes in the studio, where the assignments preceded by conceptual sketches are realized under the supervision of the Tutor. Weekly reviews of homeworks - corrections. (60 hours /sem.)
Assessment methods and criteria	50% - executing assignments. 50% - open critique of works
Assessment type	Semester 1: graded pass. Semester 2: examination review.
Literature	Valuable materials related to painters and easel painting (albums), studies on the technology of painting.
Teaching aids	The compulsory plein air workshop after the first year of study can be passed until the end of the 3rd semester (the relevant note in the student's index will be made within the 3rd semester).
