Course content	I General issues: Introduction to the general issues of private and public law. Intellectual property as a special type of legally protected property. Systematics of the intellectual property right. Genesis and sources of Polish law and international regulations; intellectual property right in the EU. II. Specific issues: II.1. Copyright: objects of copyright – a catalogue and types. Graphical work of art as a special object of the copyright regulations . Holders of the copyright and related rights, along with the copyright content and protection. Transfer of copyrights and a license contract. Organizations for collective management of copyrights and related rights, Commission of Copyright, Creativity Promotion Fund. Protection of the image in artistic activity. Related rights - the content of particular rights and their protection. Sui generis protection of databases.
