Aim of the course	The aim of the course is developing the student's general knowledge.
Prerequisites	The student reports to the tutor running a theoretical course chosen from the list of courses determined for a given academic year. They are admitted to the course, on the basis of a number of vacancies in the studio and according to criteria set by the tutor.
Learning outcomes:	
– <i>knowledge</i>	The student acquires an extended theoretical knowledge on various historical, aesthetic and philosophical aspects of cultural transformations in Europe. They obtain the grounds for interpreting the current mental transformations in the world.
– <i>skills</i>	The student is able to consciously use their knowledge in a theoretical discourse, they are able to prepare an extensive oral or written statement on a selected topic.
– <i>personal and social competence</i>	Using arguments, the student can independently account for their opinion; they recognize and are sensitive to various perspectives of interpreting and defining.
Course content	Determined by the tutor within selected classes.
Course form and number of course hours	Lectures, 30 hrs./sem.
Assessment methods and criteria	In accordance with the requirements specified by the syllabus of a chosen course.
