- skills	The student: -defines and discusses the issues concerning the use of artistic means in a diploma work, -professionally uses diverse painting techniques.
- personal and social competences	The student works well in a team, actively participates in academic life and organises open critiques of works.
Course content	Students' own proposals of painting creations Assignment of diploma works
Course form and number of course hours	Classes in the studio (9 hours a week) Individual reviews of works with a tutor. Once-a-semester open critique of works (9 th semester) performed by a commission.
Assessment methods and criteria	Final assessment is the sum of the following: 65% - working critique, active participation in classes, involvement 35% - final open critique of works
Assessment type	graded pass / examination review
Literature	Any publications about contemporary art are recommended.
