Aim of the course	The students: - learn to choose the best means and methods of formulating reflections through paintings, - study classical and modern painting techniques, - acquire theoretical knowledge and develop workshop skills, - work towards becoming conscious artists with defined artistic personalities, who use the language of art professionally and for whom painting workshop is an integral part of the construction of painting
Prerequisites	Completion of the third-year Organic Painting Techniques course
Learning outcomes:	
– knowledge	The student has very advanced, professional knowledge of painting techniques, such as: alkyd, polymer, fluorescence, air brush, graffiti.
– skills	The student designs and realises the painting in polymer and mixed techniques, which results in increased workshop awareness and in the development of his/her workshop skills.
– personal and social competence	The student: - defines their own artistic program, - communicates their own reflections using painting means, - formulates individual artistic statements reflecting the student's level of artistic awareness, - independently creates works using required techniques, - makes independent decisions regarding the realisations of the visual arts.
