Course content

Discussion of issues from the classical and contemporary philosophy; introduction to general issues of philosophy and its historical evolution; demonstrating its specificity and source for the whole of European culture. Characteristics of the classical disciplines (metaphysics, epistemology, ethics, aesthetics) and classical subjects (the problem of truth, a priori / empiricism, idealism / realism).

The main currents of the philosophy of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.

Course form and number of course hours

Classes combining lectures and seminars based on selected works of literature, philosophy; or initiating discussion of a film (30 hours / sem.)
