<b>Aim of the course</b>	The teaching goal is to gain a general knowledge about structure and specific features of philosophical reflection.

<b>Course content</b>	<p>Discussion of issues from the classical and contemporary philosophy; introduction to general issues of philosophy and its historical evolution; demonstrating its specificity and source for the whole of European culture. Characteristics of the classical disciplines (metaphysics, epistemology, ethics, aesthetics) and classical subjects (the problem of truth, a priori / empiricism, idealism / realism).</p> <p>The main currents of the philosophy of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.</p>
