Aim of the course	The main aim of the course is mastering the basic workshop skills, that allow solving glass art issues. Acquisition of practical knowledge on the material properties, based on the student's independent trials and experiments. Searching for the links between the form of a creation and the material specificity.
Prerequisites	The student's ability of imaging their own conceptions, with the use of simple graphic means.
Learning outcomes:	
– knowledge	Acquisition of a basic knowledge on glass properties and moulding methods. Getting familiar with the glass techniques used in the academy workshops. Understanding the relationship that exists between knowledge, workshop skills and artistic creation.
– skills	The student knowingly makes use of the material properties and selects an optimal realization technique. They master basic workshop skills and are able to execute simple glass forms. The student has the skills necessary to handle the equipment and tools used in the glass workshop.
– personal and social competence	The student is able to critically assess and analyze their own artistic projects and comment on the issues relating to undertaken tasks.
Course content	Assignments initiating the student's direct contact with the material. Making use of intuition in the process of searching for the form of glass objects. Discovering the relationship between an idea and its realization technique. Exploring the creative possibilities of glass, on the basis of the student's individual workshop experience.
