Aim of the course	Students learn to put in practice the rules of hand drawing and digital drawing. The aim is to develop the knowledge of drawing and to develop student's ability to choose and apply graphical means in a correct way; main emphasis is on searching for one's own solutions, with respect for the rules of perspective, readability, material qualities.
Prerequisites	Basic knowledge of presentation drawing, knowledge of the rules of perspective and basic knowledge of digital drawing tools.
Learning outcomes:	
- knowledge	Student gains advanced knowledge of presentation drawing.
- skills	Student learns to use basic drawing tools and learns about the basics of using graphic software, rules of perspective in creating concept drawings.

- personal and social competence	Student can express themselves using analogue and digital graphic tools, and present their projects.
Course content	Making drawings with digital tools and presenting the results.
