Aim of the course	The aim of this course is to develop student's skills in the area of independent design and use of graphical means; making a presentation with the use of editorial design.
Prerequisites	Knowledge of the rules of editing text in design.

- knowledge	Student gains advanced knowledge in the area of editorial design.
- skills	Student learns to independently create designs and use graphical means; in a way allowing for communication with the viewer, and with use of the rules of text editing.
- personal and social competence	Student learns to express themselves using graphical means, and to present their projects.

Course content	Learning to prepare author's own multi-page publications, and to present the finished project.
