Year of study / semester, type of studies	Year III, sem. V and VI, advanced level, full-time bachelor's degree
ECTS credits	9 pts ECTS / sem. V 6 pts ECTS / sem. VI (diploma annex chosen) 7 pts (+10 for bachelor's diploma exam) / sem. VI (if diploma at the Studio of Interior Architecture Design)
Academic tutor	Prof. Dariusz Grzybowicz, ass. tutor Karolina Cykowska, MFA
Aim of the course	The teaching goal is to make students familiar with the rules of composing interior architecture through the ability to arrange a space of relatively simple functional structure.
Prerequisites	General knowledge in the area of form and colour, rules of spatial composition, methodology of design and presentation techniques. Ability to build pattern volumes, and to use 3D software.
Learning outcomes:	
- knowledge	Student gains a deeper knowledge in the area of specific qualities of a simple architectural structure in context of the designed space, applying adequate resolutions of design.
- skills	Student learns the ability to use the toolkit necessary for participatory design, as well as in the area of creating a design documentation – implementation.

- personal and social competence	Student gains the ability to discuss, and to argue for or against specific design solutions related with the problems of shaping interior spaces.
Course content	Designing a project of a shop interior, showroom in a shopping center.
Course form and number of course hours	Classes are in form of individual consultations based on progress with a given semestral task, for the basic group (30 hours per semester). Students who make a diploma in the Studio of Interior Architecture Design: 90 hours per semester.
Assessment methods and criteria	Assessment based on progress made, activity and creativity. 50% task execution / activity during classes / progress with task realization 50% semestral review of works
Assessment type	Graded pass (winter semester), graded pass (summer semester) – if a diploma annex, diploma examination (if diploma at the Studio of Interior Architecture Design)
