Aim of the course	Introduction of specialized vocabulary and artistic language. Acquisition of the skill to use the specialized language in the scope of four basic language competencies: speaking, listening, writing and reading. Acquisition of the skill to communicate in the field of a general language at the intermediate level, based on the handbook "Taxi".
Prerequisites	Knowledge of the language at the level of B1.
Learning outcomes:	
– <i>knowledge</i>	The student has an intermediate level knowledge of the language in the scope of the vocabulary necessary for describing the creative and artistic process of various artistic techniques.
– <i>skills</i>	The student can independently analyze the artistic text in French of an average degree of difficulty. They have knowledge of a basic vocabulary and can apply it to the analysis and interpretation of the work of art and to expressing themselves.
– <i>personal and social competence</i>	The student can present their own artistic works and achievements. They take part in a discussion, express their opinions and judgements. They communicate in the scope of basic themes of art. They are prepared to take part in scholarship programmes and students exchange (Erasmus programme).
